### SAFE TABLE POLICY

St. Francis of Assisi School will provide a “Safe Table” during lunch for students who have life threatening peanut allergies or other food allergies. Students sitting at the safe table may coordinate with their teacher to bring another student eating a hot lunch to join them. The lunchroom staff will be responsible for cleaning this table before and after each lunch period.

Students in grades 1-8 participate in table captain duties (wiping down lunch tables). Please indicate if your child will be able to participate in table captain duties or if you would prefer they not participate due to food allergies.

Students in grades 3-8, with peanut/nut allergies, may sit at a lunch table other than the Safe Table with signed permission from their parent/guardian.
