- **The following are prohibited:**
 - No loitering behind or under the stadium
 - No loitering between home stands and concession stands.
 - No footballs, soccer balls, bikes, or skateboards are allowed in the stadium.
 - No pets.
 - No outside food or drink of any kind (this includes reusable water bottles).
 - No passes out of the stadium.
